The Benton Zoning and Planning Commission's public hearing was called to order by Chairman Shockley at 6:00 pm on

Wednesday, December 4, 2019 at 1403 at the Benton Municipal Building at 1403 South Main Street.

The advisory board took into evidence regarding a special use application, submitted by Laura Montgomery of 10549

Sam Pyle Bridge Rd, Benton, IL, to own and operate a home occupation business: Nail Salon with Retail Boutique at 900

N. DuQuoin Street, Benton, IL (Parcel No.: 08 18 101003) to the City of Benton.

Mr. Garavalia stated that the property, in question, was split into both R1 and R3 zoning districts. He also advised that

there could be issues regarding retail items, which are presently prohibited under home-occupation permits as they are

restricted to goods manufactured on-site.

Ms. Montgomery addressed the committee stating that she has been in business for over 30 years, in her current

location and wishes to open a nail salon and retail boutique, in-town, but had aspirations of converting the business to a

wholesale business model. Mr. Garavalia state that the proposed property appeared to have sufficient space for parking

and would not cause traffic issues.

No adjacent residents appeared at the hearing; no letters were provided via Zoning Administrator, in response to

registered letters mailed out.

A member of the audience stated that she felt the business would be a win-win for the city as it would increase tax

dollars to the city.

Ms. Montgomery added that she has clientele that travels from neighboring counties who patronize other businesses, as

well.

Having no further business, a motion to adjourn was made by Payne-Hubler and seconded by Neal.
